**The Spelling, Vocabulary, Grammar and Math Combination Test consists of 40 questions**  
Marietta answered 40 of the 40 questions.

**Overall Score:** The Overall Score is based on all 40 questions on the test. Marietta answered **27** of the 40 questions correctly resulting in an Overall Score of **67.5%**  
Weighted: **61.3%**

Questions are weighted based on the academic grade to which each is associated. The higher the grade, the higher the weight. The total weighted value of all 40 questions is a possible 391 points. Marietta scored **240** of the possible 391 points for a Weighted Score of **61.3%**

**Spelling:** The test consists of 10 questions associated with various grades of 4-8. Marietta answered **8** out of **10** questions correctly resulting in an Overall Score of **80 %**  
Weighted: **80.2%**

The total weighted value of these 10 questions is **96** points. Of these, Marietta scored **77** points resulting in a Weighted score for this category of **80.2%**.

**Vocabulary:** The test consists of 10 questions associated with various grades of 9-12. Marietta answered 5 out of 10 questions correctly resulting in an Overall Score of **50 %**  
Weighted: **44.0%**

The total weighted value of these 10 questions is **109** points. Of these, Marietta scored 48 points resulting in a Weighted score for this category of **44.0%**.

---

**Grammar:** The test consists of 10 questions associated with various grades of 13-16. Marietta answered 6 out of 10 questions correctly resulting in an Overall Score of **60 %**  
Weighted: **49.4%**

The total weighted value of these 10 questions is **95** points. Of these, Marietta scored 47 points resulting in a Weighted score for this category of **49.4%**.

**Math:** The test consists of 10 questions associated with various grades of 13-16. Marietta answered 8 out of 10 questions correctly resulting in an Overall Score of **80 %**  
Weighted: **74.7%**

The total weighted value of these 10 questions is **91** points. Of these, Marietta scored 68 points resulting in a Weighted score for this category of **74.7%**.
